NOTE: Twelve to Eighteen Months is an adult class and requires an adult entry fee.

AKC Grand Champion Select Competition (effective May 12, 2010)

The Grand Champion Select Competition Class shall be for dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed. This includes dogs transferred to Best of Breed which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. In addition, Champions that win Non-Regular Classes & become eligible for Best of Breed competition (altered or spayed Champion Veteran Class winners at independent specialties) are eligible. Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog or Select Bitch. Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed Competition.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single-Dog Entries

Veterans – for dogs and bitches 6 years and over.

Winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show. Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males and spayed bitches may be entered in the Veteran Class at independent Specialties.

Best Puppy in Regular Classes: For 1st place winners in the Regular Puppy classes following Best of Breed Competition.

Best in Veteran Class: For 1st place winners in the Veteran classes following Best of Breed Competition.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

(Winners of multiple entry classes are not eligible to compete in BOB by virtue of winning these classes)

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two, but not more than 4, of their Get. Get must be entered in a regular class at this show. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get.. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. The class will be judged on the merits of the get. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification under AKC Dog Show Rules.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows provides that castrated males and spayed bitches are allowed to be entered in Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Classes..

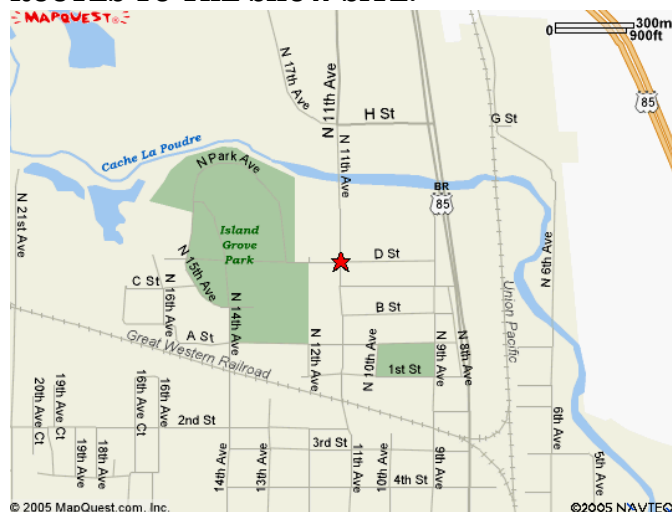

This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (Ch 11, Section 2, AKC Dog Show Rules).

Island Grove Regional Park and the City of Greeley have imposed a \$1.50-fee-per-dog entered at all its events.

Entries **CLOSE WEDNESDAY, 6:00 pm (MST) August 25, 2010**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules. A judging schedule will be mailed to each entrant as soon as practical after the closing of entries. Email notification of entry received will be sent to each exhibitor as soon as possible by the show secretary.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT FEES IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entry fee(s) will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of a Show Committee. A refund of \$3.00 or less will not be returned due to the costs of processing. Post-dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The BCOC will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in them being put on a CASH-ONLY basis.

No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary.

No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There are no refunds for duplicate entries. The Show Secretary will make an effort to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Owners and agents are responsible for errors in completing entry forms. Whoever may make such errors, no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

The Boxer Club of Colorado, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official American Kennel Club Entry Form for this event.

The owner or agent assumes all responsibilities for wrong or incomplete information on the entry form. Entries will not be accepted without fees and signatures. Entries must be made on an Official AKC Entry Form, or photocopy of the Official AKC Entry Form with the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side, or they cannot be accepted. Agents may indicate their name on entry forms for inclusion in the catalog provided they are at least 18 years old and neither own nor co-own the dog. The Denver Samoyed Association, Inc., the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for children.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging, and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club, nor the Show Secretary will be responsible nor obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the show grounds. No double handling will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

SHOW SITE INFORMATION:

The only entrance to the show site will be off 11th Ave. 14th Ave will be closed at 'A' St.

The show site will be available to exhibitors from 1:00 pm to 10:00 pm on Thursday, September 9, 2010 and 7:00 am to 10:00 pm on Friday, September 10, 2010. The site will again be available at 6:00 am to 10:00 pm on Saturday the 11th. Sunday, September 12 from 6:00 am. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following "Best in Show" judging on Sunday, September 12, 2010.

Exhibitors will not be admitted to the show grounds on Thursday, September 9, 2010, until 1:00 PM, and not admitted into any of the Buildings until 4:00 PM.

DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED OVERNIGHT IN THE BUILDINGS, PROVIDED THAT THE OWNER INFORMATION IS LEFT ON THE CRATES. ALL BUILDINGS WILL BE LOCKED BY 10:00 PM NIGHTLY & REOPEN AT 6:00 AM. A SECURITY GUARD WILL BE ON DUTY FROM 10:00 PM TO 6:00 AM. NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT OVERNIGHT IN SOFT SIDED CRATES.

No dogs may be left unattended in soft sided crates. Dogs must be in control at all times. This includes the use of Flexi-Leashes. Exercise pens in livestock barn only. **Please, no baby strollers in the show buildings.** The show grounds constitute the buildings, the outside grounds, and the parking lot. No generators allowed within 100 feet of any ring during judging times.

Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks and toilets is strictly prohibited. No dogs allowed in the rest rooms.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee of these show-giving clubs will be strictly enforced, including those not recorded in this premium.

Grooming will be available in the following buildings or outdoors: Events Center, Exhibition Building, and Livestock Barn. **Grooming areas are set up under the supervision of the Evergreen Colorado KC and BBC who may require rearrangement of exhibitors' setups where space is not properly utilized. Crates must be stacked wherever possible.** There is ample grooming space. Roping off an area or saving spaces will not be allowed unless authorized by the Show Committee. This will be strictly enforced.

A holding area for crates will be available and marked in the Community Building. Exhibitors may use this area a few minutes before, to immediately after, their breed is judged. Grooming, scissoring, etc. will not be permitted in this area.

All dogs present must be held on a leash or confined to their crates or exercise pens, except when being judged. Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crating area. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs AT ALL TIMES. No unentered dogs allowed on the show grounds during show hours.

BCOC AND EVERGREEN COLORADO KENNEL CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY ANIMAL IN DISTRESS FROM A PARKED VEHICLE OR CRATE IN ANY MANNER NECESSARY. BCOC SOLELY DETERMINES IF SAID ANIMAL IS IN DISTRESS. ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW HEREBY WAIVE ANY CLAIM FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE CLUB FOR SUCH REMOVAL.

General Parking Instructions For Island Grove Park, Greeley Colorado

LOADING & UNLOADING AREAS: 10 MINUTE TIME LIMIT. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE VEHICLES UNATTENDED. VEHICLES IN NO PARKING, FIRE LANES, OR 20 FT. FROM A FIRE HYDRANT WILL BE TICKETED OR TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE.

DAY PARKING: The paved lot south of the stadium (approx one block from the exhibition building) is available for day parking. There are no hookups in this lot. Additional day parking is available **FREE OF CHARGE** on the east side of the park & west of the show buildings. These are gravel lots. All RV's must be in their site by 8:00 PM on Friday.

GENERAL AND RESERVED PARKING INFORMATION
